December 12, 2013 – Three large-scale productions have already been scheduled for the third year of the Ruhrtriennale under the direction of Heiner Goebbels. In a six-hour screening, American artist Matthew Barney will present his latest work *River of Fundament*, a collaboration with the composer Jonathan Bepler, at Essen's Lichtburg. In 2014, French choreographer Boris Charmatz will present his first world premiere at Bochum's Jahrhunderthalle. In a new work for 14 dancers and five children, Charmatz explores a subject that is both timeless and yet very current: food.
